

Florence Pestrikoff Kuukula Memorial Scholarship

Florence Pestrikoff Kuukula worked to revitalize Alutiiq speech and expand understanding of Indigenous cultural traditions. She helped teach the first Alutiiq classes at Kodiak College and mentored a new generation of Alutiiq speakers, in partnership with the Alutiiq Museum. Florence was honored with the Margaret Nick Cook Award for her work preserving the Alutiiq language.

Recipients will receive one full scholarship for a *Grantsmanship Training Program - Online* course and textbook (value \$1,255). Recipients will have 6 months from the date of the award to register and complete the class on the dates of their choice. Applicants must be working with a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and submit:

- This application
- Documentation of 501(c)(3) status (Determination Letter from the IRS or current 990)
- Organizational budget showing revenue of \$1,000,000 or less. Budget includes revenue & expenses.

Deadline to apply for the 2024-2025 cycle is Monday, October 21, 2024.
